- Throughout the day we are implementing rigorous cleaning of our front desk and all high traffic area. All areas are being sanitized and disinfected. Cleaning Materials such as: antibacterial wipes, Lysol, bleach, soap and water are available to all employees and customers.
- All employees are up to date on CDC guidelines to ensure they are staying healthy and safe.
- We are requiring all employees to self-report if they become sick and require quarantine.
- To be proactive, we are keeping a logbook of all deliveries and all in-person customer contact. In the event a staff member needs to be self-quarantined, we will notify all customers who might have been affected.
- After each customer contact our employees will disinfect high traffic areas.
- We will proactively review each of our vendors safety protocols to ensure our employees and customers are kept as safe as possible.

Metal Shorts is staying in contact with our vendors and truck drivers to ensure access and delivery is available during this time. We will review alternate sourcing if it becomes necessary and we are working our hardest to keep available products in stock at our facility. We are doing everything in our power to keep our employees, customers, and community safe by keeping our facility a healthy environment. We will continue to closely monitor this challenging situation and will update and revise our safety protocols.
